




#### Feedback on Curriculum / Syllabus by the Students





- About 65% of the students agree that the syllabus is up-to-date and is at par with other Universities
- 67% of the students agree that the curriculum content is interesting
- 43% of the students disagree on the fact that the course content is challenging, while 24% agree on the same
- 15% of the students feel that the burden of the syllabus is high, while 82% feel that it is low
- 53% agree and 14% disagree on the fact that the duration of the course is sufficient enough to cover the entire syllabus
- 64% of the respondents felt that the course content helped them to improve their abilities to analyse and solve problems
- 65% of the students felt that the course inculcated ethical values and concerns for the society in them
- 61% reported that the recommended textbooks are easily available to them

# Feedback on Teaching Learning Process by the Students




Your overall satisfaction regarding online classes


- 63% of the respondents said that 80-100% of the syllabus was completed before their University examinations were held
- 60% of the students are of the opinion that the classes were held on time
- Approximately 60% of the students opined that the teachers were well prepared for taking classes, could communicate well and explained with the help of illustrations
- Majority of the students are happy about the fact that internal evaluation by the teachers were fair and their performance in assignments were discussed in class
- They also revealed that online classes were conducted by teachers and study materials were provided
- $\bullet$  60% of the students felt that the mentoring process in college helped in their emotional growth
- More than 30% of the respondents felt that online classes are proving to be stressful for them and online assessments create more anxiety in their minds
- Majority of the students felt that they learn better and students-teacher interaction is better in physical classrooms
- But overall they are satisfied with online mode of teaching during the pandemic


• The students are highly satisfied with the dissemination of information from the institution and the way the college addresses their grievances or queries

# Library




• The students are highly satisfied with the library resources in terms of availability of books, help from library staff, procedure of lending books
