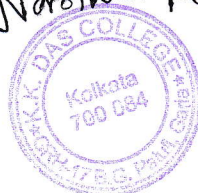

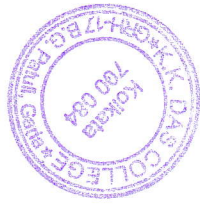
20. One training programme on software was organised for non-teaching staff.
