- 2. A candidate shall be allowed to take up HONS. in Economics if he /she has passed in Mathematics or Business Mathematics or Business Economics including Business Mathematics from of 100 marks in the previous qualifying examination
- 3. A candidate shall be allowed to take up HONS. in Mathematics if he/she has passed in Mathematics and not in Business Mathematics at the previous qualifying examination.

^{*} For Economics Honours, pass in Mathematics/Business Mathematics/B.E.B.M. at H.S. or (10+2) level is necessary.
