



## SCHOLARSHIPS AND AID FUND POLICY

### OASIS SCHOLARSHIP:

Oasis scholarship initiated by the Department of Tribal Development and the Backward Classes Welfare Department of West Bengal enables students from the SC/ST and OBC categories to pursue their education. The scholarship is exclusively available to West Bengal domiciles. The candidates can apply for the WB Oasis scholarship online through the official portal.

### Objectives:

The objective is to motivate underprivileged children aspiring to study higher

### Eligibility :

The eligibility criteria are as follows:

- The candidates from SC/ST and OBC categories studying class XI and above can apply to the post-matric Oasis scholarship
- They should belong to the **SC/ST** or **OBC** category.
- Students of **class XI** to **postgraduate** level can apply to the Oasis scholarship.
- The family income of the **SC/ST** students should not exceed **INR 2,50,000** per annum.
- The family income of the **OBC** category students should not exceed **INR 1,00,000** per annum.

### Oasis Scholarship Rewards:

- Post-matric scholarship for SC/ST students for general courses up to graduate level- INR 300 per month.
- Post-matric scholarship for SC/ST students for general courses up to graduate level- INR 210 per month.

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## AIKYASHREE:

This Scholarship for Minority Students only is provided by Govt. of WB and is available in three categories.

- Merit Cum Means
- Post Metric
- Swami Vivekananda Merit Cum Means (For all)

### Objective :

The objective of this scheme is to award interest subsidy to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of notified minority communities so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education abroad and also to enhance their employability.

### Eligibility for Post-Metric:

- (i) Applicant must be domicile of West Bengal
- (ii) Must secure 50% or equivalent marks in previous academic qualification
- (iii) Total Income must be less than 2,00,000 pa.

### Eligibility for Swami Vivekananda Merit Cum Means:

- 1) Applicant must be domicile of West Bengal
- 2) Must secure 70% or equivalent marks in previous academic qualification
- 3) Must have the previous qualification from West Bengal State Board/Council of Secondary/Higher Secondary and Madrasah Education and State University
- 4) Total Income must be less than 2,50,000 pa.

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## SWAMI VIVEKANANDA MERIT CUM MEANS SCHOLARSHIP

The SVMCM Scholarship, also known as Swami Vivekananda Scholarship, is a government program in West Bengal that provides financial support to deserving students to pursue higher education. The scheme benefits students studying in regular mode of under Graduate level in Science/Arts/Commerce. These scholarships will be sanctioned to deserving students on merit-cum-means criteria.

### Objective :

To assist the meritorious students belonging to economically backward families in the State of West Bengal to pursue higher studies, in West Bengal.

### Eligibility:

- (i) Applicants must be domiciled in the state of West Bengal.
- (ii) Students must be pursuing their studies in regular mode of one of the following:
  - a) Class 11 and 12 from West Bengal Board of Secondary Education/West Bengal Council for Higher Secondary Education/Madrassa Education for Higher Secondary level
  - b) Undergraduate level in Science/Arts/Commerce, Engineering, Medical and Technical/Professional courses from institutes approved by the AICTE and affiliated to West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development (WBSCTVE&SD)
  - c) Postgraduate level in Science/Arts/Commerce & Technical/Management courses from a recognised government institution from any State University or AICTE approved institutes of West Bengal
  - d) M.Phil and Doctoral courses (NON-NET Junior Research Fellow and NET-Lectureship) from state-aided institutions.
- iii) Applicants must fulfill the specified academic requirements to be considered eligible under the scholarship scheme.
- (iv) Total family income of the applicant should not be more than 2,50,000 per annum.

### The SVMCM Scholarship rewards:

At least 60% marks in the last qualifying exam

- Undergraduate (Arts and Commerce)- INR 1,000 per month
- Undergraduate (Science)- INR 1,500 per month

  
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## KANYASHREE PRAKALPA

Kanyashree Prakalpa Scheme is an initiative launched by the Department of Women Development and Social Welfare (DWD&SW), Government of West Bengal. It is a conditional cash transfer scheme, which aims at improving the status and wellbeing of female students.

### Objective :

Kanyashree Prakalpa Scholarship provides secondary education or vocational or sports training to girls from financially backward families to prevent and discourage their early marriages before 18 years of age. This scholarship programme offers an annual scholarship to girls between the age of 13 to 18 each year, ensuring that the girls complete their education.

Through the Kanyashree Scholarship scheme, the Department of Women Development and Social Welfare is providing students with 3 government scholarship schemes namely –

#### 1. Annual Scholarship (K1)

Under this scheme, female students between the age of 13 and 17 years 11 months will be provided with a scholarship every year. This is a State Government initiative and a method to ensure that the girls remain unmarried and study in school until they reach the legal marriage age.

#### 2. One-time Grant (K2)

Under this scheme, female students between the age of 18 and 19 will be provided with a one-time grant (financial funding).

#### 3. Kanyashree Scholarship (K3)

Under this scholarship scheme, female students from both Arts and Science backgrounds can avail financial help every month.

  
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## Eligibility:

### *Annual Scholarship (K1)*

1. The student applying for this scholarship must be a domicile of West Bengal.
2. She should be unmarried.
3. Students' family income should be less than or equal to INR 1.2 lakh per year.
4. The student should be between 13 and 17 years of age.
5. The female student must not turn 18 as this would make her ineligible for yearly scholarship benefits, and she would only be able to get a one-time benefit.
6. The female student must be enrolled between class 8 to 12th standard in Government recognised regular or equivalent school or equivalent vocational or any other technical training courses.
7. The family income limit will be varied under the following situations:
  - The student is already a recipient of the scholarship and will be applying for a renewal of the benefit
  - The student's parents (both father & mother) are deceased.
  - The student is physically handicapped.

### *One-time Grant (K2)*

1. The student applying for this scholarship must be a domicile of West Bengal.
2. She should be unmarried upon attaining the age of 18.
3. Students' family income should be less than or equal to INR 1.20 lakh per year.
4. The applicant female student should be enrolled and regularly attending an Institution of Higher Education or Training.
5. The female applicant's family income criteria can be varied only under the following cases:
  - The student's parents (both father & mother) are deceased.
  - The student is physically handicapped.

  
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## ***Kanyashree Scholarship (K3)***

1. Only the students registered for the K2 scheme would be eligible for the K3 scheme.
2. There is no maximum age limit to apply.
3. The student must have passed an undergraduate degree with at least 45% marks.
4. They must have secured admission to any postgraduate course at any University.

Kanyashree scholarship rewards are distributed amongst female students as per the schemes:

- Annual scholarship (K1 Level) - INR 750 per year
- One-Time Grant (K2 Level) - INR 25,000
- Kanyashree Scholarship (K3 Level)-
- Science stream students – INR 2,500 per month
- Arts stream students – INR 2,000 per month

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## SCHOLARSHIP AND AID FUND SUPPORT TO THE STUDENTS OF K.K.DAS COLLEGE FROM COLLEGE FUND.

### The Students' Aid Fund

It provides financial assistance to the economically weaker section in tuition fees to pursue higher education for economically weaker section .

### Eligibility:

Any students of the institution applying for the Students aid - fund are provided with the benefit

### Scholarship To The Top Rank Holder

Apart from the Government Scholarships and Student aid fund the college also provide scholarship to the Top rank holder in the respective courses annually.

### Scholarship to the Economically Weaker Students

It provides financial support to the students who are belonging to extremely weaker financial background to assist them to pursue higher studies based on their performance and regularity in class. The students to be benefitted are recommended by their respective Departmental Head and approved by the Principal of the college.
